RAISING CRITICAL FUNDS FOR CHILDREN

Buttle UK, a charity dedicated to helping children and young people who are in crisis and poverty. What we do is incredibly simple. We provide basic essential items; things all children need, but some parents and carers cannot afford, like children's beds, cookers or washing machines - and it is life changing.

We also pay for things that can help a child have a better life in the longer term: therapy or counselling where there has been domestic abuse; a laptop to enable a homeless teenager to access their first college course. Our **Chances for Children** grants offer the space for a child to move towards change rather than a life in crisis.

Buttle UK can direct funds into any areas of the UK, and so this can be matched to offices or other company locations. Due to the legacy Buttle UK left by its founder, it is able to cover its own administration costs, so 100% of donation go directly to children and young people in need.
