

## Guide to item prices (Spring 2025)

Buttle UK grants of up to £2,400 are designed to support a child's education, wellbeing, and home environment, tailored to their specific needs.

We understand that determining what to request and how much to ask for can be challenging. To assist you, we have compiled a list of commonly requested items to help you make the most impactful application for the child or young person you are supporting.

However, this is not a shopping list, and grants cannot always address all the child's needs. Additionally, if there are other items or services that better meets the child's needs, you are welcome to include it in your application.

Please remember that Buttle UK is a charity with a limited budget, and while we strive to help as much as possible, there may be some things we are unable to fund.
